Under Canada Immigration regulations, students here on a study permit must be attending an academic/educational program in order to remain in Canada.

Secondary students who are not returning home to spend time with their family in July and August have the option to attend The Greater Victoria School District's **Summer School**.

If you choose not to participate in an academic/educational program this summer, you must return home for vacation. Please remember to submit your vacation plans and **flight itinerary** on a **Travel Application Form**, available on the VIHSP website:

Summer School

Academic Completion Program: Grades 9 – 11. Location: Reynolds Secondary School

Dates: **Session 1:** July 4 - 13, 2017
Session 2: July 17 - 27, 2017

- This program is for students who did not attain a passing grade, wish to improve their grade or who wish to preview a course (no credit).

Fees: \$250 for SD61 International Students
\$375 for non-SD61 International Students

Academic Credit Program: Grades 10 – 12. Location: Reynolds Secondary School

Dates: July 4 - 27, 2017

- This program is for students who have not previously taken the course, or who wish to improve their grades. These classes are more in-depth than the completion courses.

Fees: \$500 for SD61 International Students
\$750 for non-SD61 International Students
